

## **Little Red Schoolhouse Project Selection Criteria**

All recipient schools are selected on the basis of the following criteria:

1. There must be an established immediate need for a school building to augment existing dilapidated or condemnable structures and to provide a more conducive learning atmosphere for the school children. The school is not a recipient of the DepEd-TEEP School Building Program.
2. The school site is titled in the name of DepEd and all the provisions of DECS Order No. 57, s.1995 "School Site Acquisition and Documentation for All Public Elementary and Secondary Schools" must have been satisfied. If the site has been donated, a Deed of Donation must have been perfected and duly registered with the Register of Deeds. If the school has been allowed to use the site for as long as it is used for school/education purposes, a Deed of Usufruct must have been signed between DepEd and the lot owner and likewise duly registered with the Office of the local Register of Deeds. Each potential recipient school must have at least 5,000 square meters of space to ensure ample space for the new building.
3. The school is a multi-grade elementary school and is likely to remain multi-grade for the next five years, considering the trend of enrollment. The school must have a population of at least 90 pupils for complete elementary schools (with classes from Grades 1 to 6) and at least 60 pupils for primary grades (Grades 1-4).
4. The school and the community have an organized and active partnership that supports effective learning. The parent-teacher association is willing to participate in the construction of the school building as well as assume other responsibilities to improve the total school facilities and make the same attractive for pupils, teachers and community residents.
5. The local government, particularly the barangay officials are willing to maintain the building and support the programs of the recipient schools.
6. The school must be accessible for the efficient transport and delivery of manpower and materials during the construction phase.
7. The site must be generally peaceful and secure to ensure the safety of the workforce involved in the construction and the staff monitoring the project.
